Employment Status:	Volunteer
Time Commitment:	Two regularly scheduled four-hour shifts per month equating to approximately 50 to 92 service hours annually
	Typical shifts: 10 am – 2 pm Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, Fridays, Saturdays or Sundays
Primary Functions:	Garden Docents serve several important roles:
	 Conducts garden tours Serves on-station in the gardens Assists with public programming and special events Assures a positive, enjoyable visitor experience
Key Job Elements:	Tours:
	Garden Docents conduct regularly scheduled garden tours throughout the spring and fall seasons (April through June and September through November equating to approximately 22 weeks annually). They also conduct specially scheduled VIP, focus, and/or group tours in the gardens.
	On-Station Service:
	Occasionally Garden Docents serve on-station in the gardens, where they provide directions to visitors, answer specific questions about the gardens and plants/objects in the collection, and explain audio tour use.
	Scheduling:
	 Submits monthly availability via Volgistics, the online scheduling software Attends regular volunteer continuing education sessions and any scheduled mandatory volunteer training sessions Participates in periodic reviews Honors the time commitment requested of docents
Organizational Relationships:	 Reports to Volunteer Supervisor Collaborates with Interpretation and Horticulture staff and management Interacts with staff, fellow volunteers and visitors of all ages
Knowledge:	 Interested in the horticulture and decorative arts Interested in teaching and/or curriculum delivery

While volunteering a docent is regularly required to communicate professionally in person, over the telephone, through email and other electronic means, stand for extended periods of time outside (rain or shine, except during severe weather conditions), ascend/descend stairs, move about their volunteer area, between buildings, and the campus grounds, and visually or otherwise identify, observe and assess.
