FROM EXILE TO AVANT GARDE: THE LIFE OF PRINCESS NATALIE PALEY

In 2022, Hillwood acquired the Paley/Romanoff collection, which includes over 300 items, that originally belonged to the family of Princess Olga Paley (1865-1929) and Grand Duke Paul Alexandrovich (1860-1919), and their progeny including Princess Natalie Paley (1905-1981). As we prepare for our June 2025 exhibition From Exile to Avant Garde: The Life of Princess Natalie Paley which will be curated by Hillwood's Curator of Textiles, Apparel, Jewelry and Accessories Megan Martinell, we continue conservation and study of the collection as well as professional photography. The exhibition will focus on the fascinating figure of Princess Natalie Paley and explore her life in Belle Epoque Paris where her parents lived in exile and where she was born.
