**Russian Imperial Easter Eggs**

From 1885 to 1916, the firm of Fabergé produced fifty imperial Easter eggs given as gifts to either Maria Fedorovna or Alexandra Fedorovna. Two additional eggs were never delivered due to the 1917 Revolution. The table below provides details about each egg, with Hillwood's two eggs highlighted in yellow.

Please note that the location of an imperial Fabergé egg may change over time due to loan agreements, transfers within private collections, or other circumstances. This list was last updated on February 11, 2026.
